Terms and conditions

Entries must be the original work of the exhibitor. Any medium or material is accepted. All work entered must be no bigger than 150cm x 150cm, no smaller than 20cm x 20cm and up to 10kg in weight. All paintings must have a wire or rope across the back in order to be hung. Sculptors must provide their own plinths if the artwork requires one. No wet paintings will be accepted.

Entrants must supply images in the form of either: photograph, colour copy, JPEG, PDF, on CD or DVD, with the application form and entrance fee by *[entry closing date]*. Please email digital images to *[your contact details]*. A selection team will view all entries and make a selection of the work that is submitted by this entry form. Selected works must be delivered to *[your venue]* by *[date]*. Each work must be marked clearly on the back with the entrant's name and contact details, title of work and medium. All artworks are submitted at the artist's own risk. Artists are required to collect their work from *[venue]* on *[date and time]*.
