- 1) Federal Government policy on climate change as a "package", including greenhouse gas reduction targets, emissions trading, renewable energy target, funding to poor countries to cope with the effects of climate change.
- 2) Community responses to Federal Government policy.

Our speakers include a representative from the Department of Climate Change, international development and grass roots campaigners, and a renewable energy expert. Most of our speakers are people from faith backgrounds. There will be generous time for questions and discussion. People of faith are especially encouraged to come along.
